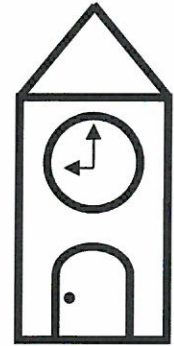

### School Improvement Plan

I am writing to inform you that as a result of assessment data at the end of July 2017 being below national expectation at KS1 and KS2, the Local Authority has again issued a Warning Notice expressing their concern about pupil progress and attainment.

The Governing Body and newly appointed Leadership Team are taking immediate action to address these concerns and have developed a focused School Improvement Plan aimed at raising standards in attainment and achievement across the school. We strongly believe that we have capacity to lead these improvements and are fully committed to addressing key issues and priorities as outlined below:

- Leadership and Management
  - To ensure that all teaching is good or outstanding
  - To develop and embed effective leadership across the school
  - To review the teaching of core subjects to ensure good progress and curriculum coverage
- Teaching, Learning and Assessment
  - To use marking and feedback appropriately to raise attainment and progress
  - To ensure all staff demonstrate secure subject knowledge and use planning effectively to maximise learning opportunities
  - To maintain progress from EYFS to KS1 & KS1 to KS2, at least in line with national expectations and to increase percentage of pupils achieving Age Related Expectation and Greater Depth Standard
- Personal Development, Behaviour & Welfare, including Safeguarding
  - To embed the school's Vision and Values
  - To ensure safeguarding is effective across the school


