### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Preparing for our new classes  
Meeting new teachers and friends  
Recognising that taking part and trying our best, not always winning, is important in sporting events.  
Caring for animals and pets  
Preparing for and taking part in a trip away from school  
Looking after/caring for animals and plants  
Children to undertake litter pick/highlight litter harmful to minibeasts  
To remember to keep our classroom tidy and offer a helping hand to others.  
To continue to consider our own and others feelings, placing our photo in the relevant emotion chest.

### Communication and Language

Role play in 'The Farm shop' and 'home'.  
Develop and use topic vocabulary hooves, fur, tails, horns, fleece  
Asking experts questions to find out information  
Listening to farm stories e.g. Old Macdonald, Baaboom, Farmer Duck, Animals on the farm etc  
A day in the life of a farmer... **visit from a farmer and to a farm.**  
Listening to poems e.g. animal riddles 'What am I?'  
Create and develop their own dinosaur  
Retell stories told without props or pictures  
Use correct tenses when sharing news

## Literacy - See Literacy Overview

### Knowledge and Understanding of the World

Farms and farmers - role play  
Matching animal babies and parents  
Caring for animals and watching them grow  
Caring for plants.  
Watching our seeds grow  
How to stay healthy when it is hot  
Ways to stay safe on holiday e.g. stranger danger  
Growing vegetables, plants, tomatoes etc.  
ICT Farm mat - planning routes from farm delivering eggs  
Visit a local farm to handle and observe animals  
ICT - My World create own minibeast  
Lifecycle of a frog/caterpillar  
Label parts of a plant  
Look at animal covers - skin, fur, scales, wool, and feathers.

### Physical development

To develop ball skills  
To understand how to keep our bodies safe in the sun  
To write letters using correct formation, and a consistent size  
Animal movements - travelling safely and imaginatively  
Sports day practice  
Tweezing seeds from fruit and vegetables  
Operate wheeled toys with care and control - pretend wheeled toys are farm vehicles, make a farmyard route for tractors to drive around

### Expressive arts and Design

Singing songs e.g. old MacDonald had a fun  
Making musical instruments Recognise repeated sounds and sound patterns (rhythm)  
Simple composition  
To move like animals/ dinosaurs in response to a story/music  
Drawing/painting animals/ dinosaurs using fine details  
Role play - farm shop  
Children to design and make large/small homes for chosen minibeast  
Create symmetrical butterflies  
Observational drawings of plants, farm animals  
Make collages out of natural materials collected on farm visit
