Measuring the impact on educational attainment of PPG spending

- Teachers will meet with the Headteacher, Assistant Headteacher and Inclusion Co-ordinator for half-termly Pupil Progress Meetings
- During PPMs, knowledge of age-related expectations and expected progress will be used when considering the impact of PPG related interventions
- PPMs will also involve rigorous questioning which focuses on barriers to learning and actions that are needed to overcome these barriers
- PPG pupils are tracked individually and progress measured half-termly; this is monitored by the Headteacher
- The INCo will review provision maps alongside class teachers measuring impact and conducting thorough evaluation
- Key children will be focussed on to secure good and better progress through individualised educational support as appropriate
