## Knowledge and understanding

Here are a few tips to work on your pronunciation in Spanish:

The letter 'h' is always silent unless it is next to the letter 'c' (ch), e.g. hola [hello]. The letter 'c' is pronounced like an English 'th' when in front of an 'i' or 'e', e.g. cero [zero], cinco [five]. In Spain, the letter 'z' is always pronounced like an English 'th', e.g. diez [ten]. In Spain, the letter 'v' is pronounced 'b', e.g. nueve [nine]. The letters 'll' are pronounced 'y' like in 'yesterday', e.g. me llamo [I'm called]. The letter 'ñ' is pronounced 'nye' like in 'new', e.g. señor [sir, Mr]. The letters 'qu' only appear before the vowels 'e' and 'i' and the 'u' is always silent, e.g. ¿Qué tal? [How are you?].

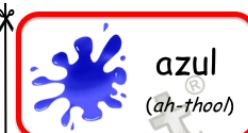
